

Parish Councillor's Presentation

Inspectors Hannah LUCHESA and Richard LANE

Basingstoke District - local policing (Neighbourhood Policing Teams - NPTs).



- ▶ District Commander - Ch Insp Matt REEVES.
- ▶ District divided into two Sectors, each run by an Inspector at Tadley and our Parklands Office. Each Sector is subdivided into a number of Beats.
- ▶ Two NPTs in the town and one rural - each run by a Sergeant and consisting of a number of PCs and PCSOs allocated to Beats.
- ▶ The District also provides a High Harm Team and DRH Team and a Countrywatch team.

Other policing resources.

- ▶ Response and Patrol Teams.
 - ▶ Five teams working 24/7 who work from our Parklands Office.
- ▶ Police Investigation Teams.
 - ▶ Work from the Police Investigation Centre in Jays Close. These officers investigate offence from the Basingstoke, Rushmoor, Hart, Test Valley, Winchester and East Hants District areas. A 24/7 Custody Block with 36 cells is located here.
- ▶ Force Wide Policing Assets
 - ▶ Including Dog, Roads Policing, Armed Response and Specialist Policing Resources.

Four Pillars of Neighbourhood Policing and how we manage our work


- ▶ Safeguarding.

High Harm.


- ▶ Working in partnership, our local priorities are focused on managing High Harm issues which include:
 - ▶ Reducing offences linked to the most serious types of violence, for example robberies, knife linked offences, rape and the most serious assault offences.
 - ▶ Reducing offences linked to the supply of controlled drugs (specifically heroin and crack cocaine).
 - ▶ Reducing offences linked to the sexual and criminal exploitation of young children. Closely associated to this is the management of those who are deemed to be repeat missing persons.
 - ▶ Reducing offences linked to Domestic Violence.

Problem Solving - current crime trends.




Acquisitive Crime - the general trend is downwards.

BASINGSTOKE - 4b Vehicle Offences




ASB and Criminal Damage the general trend is downwards.

- ▶ Owned by PCSO Lucy OLLERENSHAW (East Beat - Chineham and Basing).
- ▶ Key messaging - reporting and 101 (report on line instead).
